Dear Friends

"Jesus is the reason for the Season." I see a few lapel badges around at this time of the year reminding passers by that Christmas is more than mince pies, migraines, and moaning about those terrible socks/soaps/smellies (choose your own pet hate!) that Uncle George sent at Christmas, for which we have no use or inclination. Conversely of course, quite a lot of those passing by will have no use or inclination for the Christian message at Christmas or any other time of the year. Globally, the world still remains very religious but here in the UK we are part of a strange minority - people who see Christmas primarily as a religious celebration in a wider culture that, increasingly, according to surveys, declares that it is not religious.

Here at All Saints, we'll be doing our bit in December to encourage the indifferent and undecided to give our message a second look. To step inside our church and sing; to be quiet and remember what really matters as another year ends; to look at the tree and crib and perhaps remind themselves that a sense of wonder is still possible, even in a dark and broken world. We shall be carol singing in the parish and holding special Christmas services: one that will bring friends from local churches at 6.30pm on Sunday, 10th December; the other at 4.30pm on Christmas Eve, with families and young children particularly in mind. Full details can be found in the notices and special leaflets at the back of church. Do tell others and be present yourself. Perhaps this Christmas, as we gather together, lives might be changed a little, and the love of Jesus known a little better.
