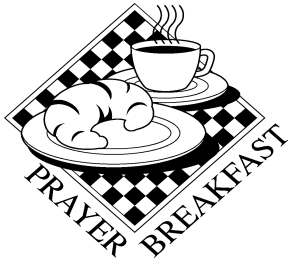
Tickets (£7) are available from Lesley

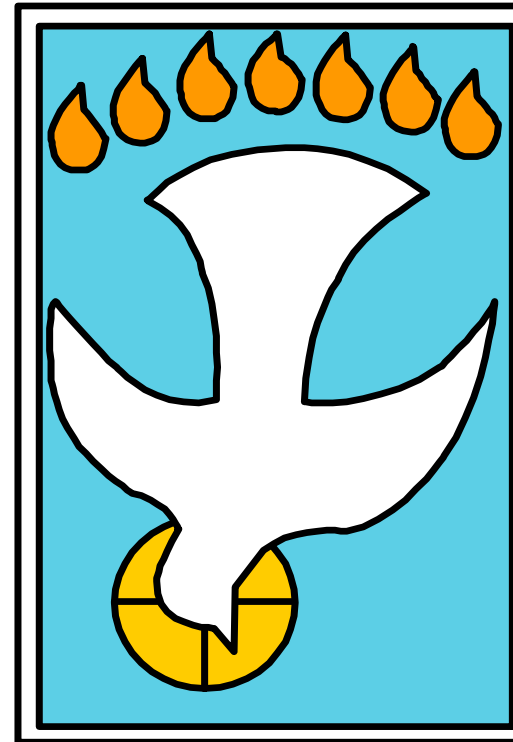


(before the Coffee & Cake !)
